### Second Election Results Update for the March 7<sup>th</sup> Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the Consolidated Municipal and Special Elections.

The update includes **183,820** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **845,007**, which is **16.08%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.
