MAR. 27 (W) E-48	CERTIFIED LIST OF CANDIDATES Last day for the Secretary of State to send the certified list of candidates to the county elections official.
APR. 4 (Th) E-40	APR 23 (Tu) E-21 MAIL SAMPLE BALLOTS A sample ballot booklet shall be mailed to each voter in the district during this period. (E. C. § 13303)
APR. 15 (M) E-29	POLLWORKERS AND POLLING PLACES – APPOINTMENT Last day to appoint pollworkers and designate polling places. A notice of appointment shall be mailed to each pollworker appointed. (E. C. §§ 12286, 12307 and 12319)
APR 15 (M) E-29	MAY 7 (Tu) E-7 VOTE BY MAIL – FIRST AND LAST DAY TO APPLY Applications may be filed between these dates (both dates inclusive). Applications received prior to the 25th day preceding the election will be kept and processed during this period. (E. C. §§ 3001 and 10704)
APR. 29 (M) E-15	REGISTRATION CLOSES Last day to transfer or register to vote in the election. (E. C. §§ 2102 and 2107)

APR. 30 (Tu) E-14		<p>BILINGUAL PRECINCT OFFICER LIST</p> <p>Last day to prepare list of appointed bilingual precinct officers. (E. C. § 12303)</p>
MAY 4 (Sa) E-10		<p>CENTRAL TALLY LOCATION PUBLICATION</p> <p>Not later than this date a notice specifying the public place to be used as the tally center for counting the ballots shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the district. (E. C. § 12109 and Govt. § 6061)</p>
MAY 7 (Tu) 5:00 P.M. E-7		<p>POLLING PLACES PUBLICATION</p> <p>Not later than this date, a list of polling places for each precinct shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the district. (E. C. §§ 12105, 12106 and Govt. Code § 6061)</p> <p>CANVASS VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</p> <p>The canvass may commence on the 7th day before the election, but the results of the tally shall not be released until after the polls close. (E. C. § 15101(b))</p> <p>COMPUTER PROGRAM TO SECRETARY OF STATE</p> <p>Last day to send copy of computer vote counting program and Certificate of Logic and Accuracy Test to Secretary of State. (E. C. § 15001)</p>
MAY 8 (W) E-6	MAY 14 (Tu) ELECTION DAY	<p>EMERGENCY VOTE BY MAIL VOTING</p> <p>Between these dates, any voter may apply for a Vote By Mail ballot if conditions require his or her absence from the precinct on election day. The voter may designate an authorized representative to pick-up and return the ballot. (E. C. §§ 3021 and 3110)</p>

<p>MAY 14 (Tu) 8:00 P.M. ELECTION DAY</p>	<p>ELECTION DAY Polls open 7:00 a.m. and close 8:00 p.m. (E. C. § 14212)</p> <p>NOTE: If at the hour of closing, there are any other qualified voters in the polling place or in line at the door, who have not been able to vote since appearing, the polls shall be kept open a sufficient amount of time to enable them to vote. (E. C. § 14401)</p> <p>VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS RETURNED – 8:00 P.M. Last day for Vote By Mail ballots to be received or turned in personally by the voter at any polling place in the jurisdiction. A designated family member may return the voted ballot under specified conditions. (E. C. §§ 3017 and 3020)</p>
<p>MAY 15 (Th) E+1</p> <p>MAY 24 (F) E+10</p>	<p>OFFICIAL CANVASS During this period, the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk will conduct the official canvass.</p>
<p>MAY 29 (W) E+15</p>	<p>COMPLETION OFFICIAL CANVASS Last day for County Elections Official to certify the results to the Secretary of State.</p>
