1.6 Million Vote-by-Mail LA County Voters Receive “I Voted Sticker” For First Time

LOS ANGELES - Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced that 1.6 million Los Angeles County Vote-By-Mail voters have received an “I Voted” sticker with their Vote by Mail Ballot this week.

This is the first time that Vote-by-Mail voters in Los Angeles County have received the iconic “I Voted” sticker to mark their participation in this year’s important election.

“The most influential method of increasing voter participation is peer-to-peer outreach,” said Logan. “When people share the value and importance of voting with those in their personal and professional network, the likelihood their peers will vote goes up. The “I Voted” sticker serves as a symbolic statement that voting is a part of community.”
