Vote by Mail Ballots Mailed for the Norwalk-La Mirada Unified School District Special Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing Vote by Mail ballots to all eligible registered voters in the Norwalk-La Mirada Unified School District for the July 20 Special Election.

Voters can track the mailing of their Vote by Mail ballot with [Where's My Ballot](#).

We encourage voters to safely participate in this election by returning their mail-in ballot early. There are several safe return options available:

- Return by mail, no postage required – must be postmarked by Election Day
- Drop off at a [Ballot Drop Box](#)
- Drop off at a [Vote Center](#) – Beginning July 10th

Starting today, voters can visit the RR/CC Headquarters in [Norwalk](#) to safely vote early in-person. All public health and safety guidelines will be followed, and voters will be required to wear a facial covering.
