AGREEMENT WITH EDISON MEDIA RESEARCH
FOR 2008 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION SNAP TALLY
(ALL SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS)
(3-VOTE)**

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

Approve the conduct of snap tally services in 20 of the 4,379 precincts throughout the County in the February 5, 2008 Presidential Primary Election at the request of Edison Media Research.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

For many years, Los Angeles County has made snap tally services available to the news media to enable them to establish voting trends in certain election contests.

Snap tallies are specifically authorized by Elections Code sections 14440-14443.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The recommended action supports the County's Strategic Plan:

Goal No. 1: Service Excellence: Provide the public with easy access to quality information and services that are both beneficial and responsive.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

Costs associated with the snap tally process are estimated at \$500 to cover an additional \$25 Pollworker stipend for each Inspector performing snap tally services.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/ LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Snap tallies do not interfere with the conduct of the election. Snap tallies take place after all the polls have closed and do not, in any way, delay the County's tally of election results. The attached statement from Edison Media Research (Attachment I) reaffirms their policy of not releasing such results until all the polls in the State of California have closed.


IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

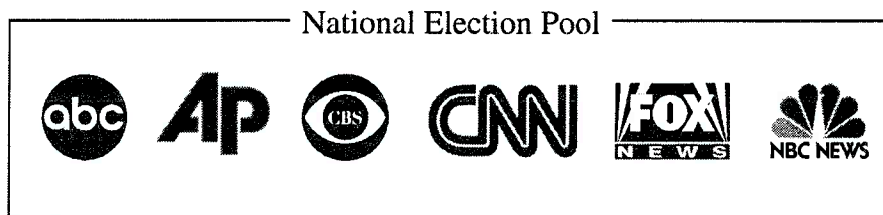
