Second Election Results Update for the May 14 LAUSD District 5 Special Runoff Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the May 14 LAUSD District 5 Special Runoff Election.

The update includes **1,536** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **28,944**, which is **9.21%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **45** Vote by Mail ballots.

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the [Official Election Canvass](#) period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
