Dear Ms. Rivers:

This document serves as notice of intention to circulate a petition to implement the attached county initiative. The proposed initiative would implement a "3% at 50" retirement plan for the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department public safety employees.

As of May 15, 2002, there were 196 local agencies that offered a 3% at 50 retirement bonus plan for local safety members through the California Public Employee's Retirement System (CalPERS) and 37 Act Counties. Despite their commitment to insuring the safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Los Angeles, however, the employees of the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department are still not offered this retirement benefit program. The attached initiative seeks to remedy this situation through the support of the voters of Los Angeles County.



### **Los Angeles Sheriff's Department "3% at 50" Retirement Benefit Plan Initiative**

Notwithstanding any other provision of existing law, a person who is a qualifying member of the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department on or after November 5, 2002, shall participate in the Federal Social Security (Retirement, Disability, Health Insurance) System, and may elect to participate in the California Public Employees' Retirement System "3% at 50" retirement benefit plan. The initiative shall not be construed to abrogate or diminish any vested pension or retirement benefit that may have accrued under an existing law to an above mentioned qualifying member, but upon adoption of this act no further entitlement to nor vesting in any existing programs shall accrue to any such person, other than the Social Security System and the "3% at 50" program to the extent herein provided.

This initiative seeks to implement the described retirement program by mandating that the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors exercise its power to adopt a resolution providing for the applicability of Government Code §31664.1.
