

LOS ANGELES COUNTY POLLWORKER PROGRAM

★ ★ ★ FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ★ ★ ★

Where will I be assigned to serve on Election Day?

County pollworkers are assigned to polling places where there is a critical shortage of pollworkers. You may be assigned to a poll location near your home, office or (if willing) anywhere in Los Angeles County, as needed.

Are County employees allowed to attend pollworker training during working hours?

Attending training during working hours is at the discretion of the Department Head.

I submitted my County Pollworker Application and I have not been contacted, how will I know if I was assigned?

County employees who are assigned will receive a pollworker packet via mail. The packet will include an appointment letter, a training schedule, and other informational materials regarding Election Day. We encourage County employees to submit their application early in the recruitment process to allow our office sufficient time for processing.

I live outside Los Angeles County, can I still participate in the Los Angeles County Employee Pollworker Program?

Yes, if you are a Los Angeles County employee you can still participate in the program even though you live outside the County as long as you serve at a polling place in Los Angeles County.

If I serve as a pollworker in another county, will I still get paid my departmental salary?

Participation in the Los Angeles County Employee Pollworker Program **only** applies to County employees who serve in Los Angeles County precincts. It is not our policy to pay pollworkers' salaries who serve outside of Los Angeles County.

Can I request to change my location once I have been assigned to a polling place?

Due to the strict guidelines and strategic planning that goes into pollworker placement, it is extremely difficult to reassign pollworkers to a different polling place location. However, if you have extenuating circumstances surrounding your request, please call (800) 815-2666 Option 7 and we will attempt to accommodate you.

Who do I contact if I am no longer available to serve on Election Day and need to cancel?

If you are no longer available to serve you need to contact our office as soon as possible by phone at (800) 815-2666 Option 7.

How will my supervisor verify that I served on Election Day?

"Proof of Service" forms are available in the Election Supply Tub at the polling place. If your supervisor requests proof that you served on Election Day, request a signed Proof of Service from the Inspector at your polling place at the end of the night.

When will I receive my stipend for serving on Election Day?

Stipends are mailed out 4-6 weeks following Election Day. If you do not receive a stipend within this timeframe, please contact our office via phone at (562) 462-2023 or via email at countypollworker@rrcc.lacounty.gov.
