


HIGH SCHOOL VOTER ENGAGEMENT

Act now to begin planning a campus registration drive.

Registering to vote is the first step in becoming an active engaged voter. Every single voter in Los Angeles County, regardless of age, has the power to impact the outcome of an election.

Millions of Californians are eligible to vote but are not registered. Younger populations have the largest gap between those eligible to register to vote and those actually registered. Student leaders play a key role in reaching out to eligible voters in student communities.

The Registrar's office supports high school voter education by assisting students and faculty with campus registration drives. One or more pupils are identified as voter outreach coordinators. A community and voter outreach team member from the office of the Registrar guides the student(s) as they coordinate voter registration activities and offer voter education opportunities on the high school campus.








You can pre-register to vote if you are at least 16.
