<b>MAR. 13 (W)</b> E – 62	<b>MAR. 15 (F)</b> E – 60	<p><b>VOTE RECORDER PAGE PROOFS</b>  <b>Recommended</b> period for the county elections official to deliver copies of official ballot proofs to the City Clerk for approval.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> Corrections to any ballot material must be submitted to the county elections official within 24 hours of receipt.</p>
<b>APR. 4 (Th)</b> E – 40	<b>APR. 23 (Tu)</b> E – 21	<p><b>MAILING OF OFFICIAL SAMPLE BALLOT BOOKLET</b>            An Official Sample Ballot Booklet shall be mailed to each voter during this period.            (E. C. § 13303)</p>
<b>APR. 15 (M)</b> E – 29		<p><b>PRECINCT BOARD MEMBER AND POLLING PLACES – APPOINTMENT</b>            Last day to appoint precinct boards and designate polling places. A notice of appointment shall be mailed to each precinct officer.            (E. C. §§ 12286, 12307 and 12319)</p> <p><b>MAILING OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</b>            First day the elections official delivers Vote By Mail ballots in compliance with E.C. 3001.            (E. C. § 3010 and 3206)</p>
<b>APR. 15 (M)</b> E – 29	<b>MAY 7 (Tu)</b> E – 7	<p><b>VOTE BY MAIL – FIRST AND LAST DAY TO APPLY</b>            Applications may be filed between these dates (both dates inclusive). Applications received prior to the <b>29<sup>th</sup></b> day preceding the election will be kept and processed during this period.            (E. C. § 3001)</p>

<b>APR. 29 (M)</b> E – 15	<b>CLOSE OF REGISTRATION</b> Last day to transfer or register to vote in the election. (E. C. §§ 2102 and 2107)
<b>APR. 30 (Tu)</b> E – 14  <b>MAY 14 (Tu)</b> 8:00 P.M. ELECTION DAY	<b>NEW CITIZEN REGISTRATION/VOTING</b> A new citizen is eligible to register and vote at the office of, or at another location designated by, the county elections official at any time beginning on the <b>14th</b> day before an election and ending at the close of polls on the election day following the date on which that person became a citizen. (E. C. § 3500)
<b>APR. 30 (Tu)</b> E – 14	<b>PROCESSING VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</b> The processing of vote by mail ballots may commence on the <b>10<sup>th</sup></b> business day before the election but the results of the tally shall not be released until after the polls close. (E. C. § 15101(b))  <b>BILINGUAL PRECINCT BOARD MEMBER LIST</b> Last day to prepare list of appointed bilingual precinct board members. (E. C. § 12303)
<b>MAY 4 (Sa)</b> E – 10	<b>TALLY CENTER LOCATION – PUBLICATION</b> On or before this date a notice specifying the public place to be used as the central tally location for counting the ballots shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the jurisdiction. (E. C. § 12109 and Govt. § 6061)
<b>MAY 7 (Tu)</b> E – 7	<b>POLLING PLACES – PUBLICATION</b> On or before this date a list of polling places for each precinct shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the city. (E. C. § 12105 and Govt. Code § 6061)  <b>NOTICE OF LIST OF NOMINEES – PUBLICATION</b> On or before this date, the City Clerk shall publish a list of nominees once in a newspaper of general circulation within the city. (E. C. § 12110 and Govt. Code § 6061)

<b>MAY 8 (W)</b> E – 6	<b>MAY 14 (Tu)</b> <b>EMERGENCY VOTE BY MAIL</b> ELECTION DAY Between these dates any voter may apply for a Vote By Mail ballot if conditions require his or her absence from the precinct on election day. The voter may designate an authorized representative to pick up and return the ballot. (E. C. §§ 3021 and 3110)
<b>MAY 14 (Tu)</b> <b>8:00 P.M.</b> <b>ELECTION DAY</b>	<b>ELECTION DAY</b> Polls open 7:00 a.m., close 8:00 p.m. (E. C. §§ 1200 and 14212)  <b>VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS RETURNED – 8:00 P.M.</b> Last day for Vote By Mail ballots to be received or turned in personally by the voter at any polling place in the jurisdiction. An authorized representative may return the voted ballot under specified conditions. (E. C. §§ 3017 and 3020)  Any Vote By Mail ballot cast under this division shall be timely cast if it is received by the voter’s elections official via the United States Postal Service or a bona fide private mail delivery company no later than three days after election day in addition to the provisions set forth in E. C. 3020, Sections 1 and 2. (E. C. § 3020(b) Section 1 and 2)
<b>MAY 16 (Th)</b> E + 2	<b>OFFICIAL CANVASS</b> The canvass of election returns shall commence no later than the first Thursday following the election. (E. C. §§ 10262 and 15301)
<b>MAY 24 (F)</b> E + 10	<b>COMPLETION OF OFFICIAL CANVASS</b> The county elections official shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to each jurisdiction within 30 days of the election. For this election, certification is scheduled to occur within 10 days. (E. C. § 15372)  <b>NOTE:</b> On <b>May 24, 2019</b> the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is tentatively scheduled to certify the election results. On <b>June 4, 2019</b> the Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election officially concluded. (E. C. § 15400)
