
WHAT'S NEW IN THE 2022 PRIMARY ELECTION?

Impact of Census and Citizens' Redistricting Commission

- After the national census (conducted in 2020), the California Citizens' Redistricting Commission updated district boundaries across the state
- Some voters may be in new Congressional, State Assembly, State Senate, and State Board of Equalizations districts
- Voters will see contests and candidates for their new district
- Check which districts you live in by visiting LAVOTE.GOV/MYDISTRICT




Two Concurrent Elections for U.S. Senate Seat

There are two U.S. Senate contests on this ballot

 One for the regular 6-year term ending January 3, 2029

• One for the remainder of the current term ending January 3, 2023

Voters can vote for both contests



WHAT'S NEW IN THE 2022 PRIMARY ELECTION?

Assembly District 62 Special General Election

- A special election was held on April 5, 2022 to fill a vacancy in the 62nd Assembly District
- The top two candidates who received the most votes in the special election are in a runoff election for the remainder of the short term (ending December 5, 2022)
- The runoff election is included on the June 7, 2022 Primary Election ballot
- Due to the redistricting, many of the voters who are eligible to vote in the runoff election now live in the 61st Assembly District
- These voters will see two contests on their ballot:
 - Members of the State Assembly, 61st District Full term
 - Members of the State Assembly, 62nd District Short term ending on December 5, 2022
- Voters can vote for both contests
